



Interconnection and Non-Discrimination Policy

TOWARDEX (“TWDX”) operates fiber networks in Massachusetts, providing high-capacity, point-to-point and point-to-multipoint private line transport services and Internet connectivity service.

TWDX does not manage or limit the content of communications traffic transiting TWDX’s networks, except to the extent necessary to maintain reliable service. TWDX’s network management practices do not involve preferential routing of traffic on the basis of content or provider. TWDX utilizes neutral traffic routing and transit and enables connections to other carriers and to the public Internet. TWDX displays its network management policies in a prominent location on its web site, and will provide notice to customers of changes to these policies.

TWDX negotiates with bona fide requesting parties to interconnect with its networks on negotiated, commercially-reasonable terms and conditions.
